

Scholarship Program

The K.A.A.F. Scholarship is available to graduating seniors from High Schools within Kalamazoo County. Eight scholarships will be awarded per year. The applicants do not need to participate in athletics during college. The applicants shall carry a “C” composite grade average of college core classes. The applicants should exhibit above average citizenship and leadership qualities. The applicants shall submit a completed application form. The applicants shall submit a letter in resume form listing their achievements, aspirations, community service, and any other relative information. They should also include a letter of no more than two hundred (200) words stating why they should receive the scholarship, two (2) letters of recommendation (one from their Coach and/or their athletic Director, and one from a Teacher and/or Clergy), and High School Transcript.

Scholarship value is seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) and will be issued in full upon receipt of a registration form from the university or college of their choice. This is a one time award per scholarship. Application deadline is June 1st of senior year and can be e-mailed to KAAF.april@gmail.com or mailed to:

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Applicants should be participants of a Women's Softball or Men's Baseball Team, however they need not be players (i.e. team managers, assistants, etc)
2. Applicants shall be graduating seniors for the scholarship year
3. Applicants shall carry a "C" composite grade average of college core classes
4. Applicants shall exhibit above average citizenship qualities
5. Applicants shall exhibit leadership qualities
6. Applicants shall submit a completed application form
7. Applicants shall additionally submit in resume form their achievements, aspirations, community service and any other relative information
8. Applicants shall submit a letter of no more than 200 words stating why they believe they should receive a scholarship from K.A.A.F.
9. Applicants do not need to participate in athletics during college
10. Applicants shall submit two (2) letters of recommendation from a Coach and/or Athletic Director and a Teacher and/ or Clergy
11. Applicants shall submit a high school transcript
12. Recipients are requested to make themselves available to receive their award during a KAAF Award Ceremony.
